

Alexandra Back In Front of the Camera

- Alexandra, you and Rebecca (Liljeberg, so-star in **Show Me Love**) could be Babalou Smith's video girls much like Alicia Silverstone and Liv Tyler are for Aerosmith.
- Yeah, maybe. But I need to check with Rebecca first (laughs).
