- Yes, my mother is Russian and my grandmother lives there. I was in Russia when I was little. When I grow up, I want to live there because I love it so much that I become crazy.

When do you blush?

- I don't think it's good to be ashamed so it's better not to blush.

When do you get angry?

- When I watch TV. I think it's the worst chore, a nice thing to do, but I get angry because it's so damn cliché and people say such stupid things.

What's the worst gossip you've heard about yourself?

- That Mathias Rust and I are together. But it's not terrible because he's a great guy.
