*A Beautiful World* by Sergi Belbel produced by Darling Desperados is described as "a thrilling and psychedelic dream play".

## **What is the play about?**

- It's about what a person is worth and the limits on how much bad one can do to achieve the good. Everyone in the play wants a beautiful world, but they need to re-evaluate things along the way.

## **Humid Director**

In the play, we meet a sex addict, a plastic surgeon, a humid director, a gay man who is fiercely in love and a depressed writer - among others.

- Yes, there are a number of people. My character you should feel sorry for, I think, but most should be laughed at. The damp director is really funny!

## **Orphan**

Alexandra plays an orphan girl of twelve years old.

- Yes, but she lies and says she's 15. She wants to think older - that one always.

**The girl is taken care of by a couple who are terrorists, which creates some problems with her values.**

- Yes, she would be happy to help. She knows nothing and does not understand that it's wrong to use violence to achieve her goal. But she has such a nice part in the play, really. But how can I not tell you!

**You have played at the Royal Dramatic Theatre in the past - is it a big difference?**

- (Laughs) Yes, there is a stark contrast. But everyone was very kind to me and I didn't need to be nearly as nervous as I thought.
