## Alexandra Dahlström at Film Camp

Scenkonstbolaget got an early start this year with the Swedish Film Institute sponsoring their film camp for young female filmmakers.

Now they can add a really hot presenter, director and actress Alexandra Dahlström.

"It's a real win for us," says film consultant Anders Justin.

Scenkonstbolaget film has now identified the name of the presenter during summer film camp for young female filmmakers.

The director and actress Alexandra Dahlström, known from *Show Me Love*, is the last card in a really hot hand of film professionals.

"It's a real win for us. She is both a young female directors and is a good role model for young women in the film industry. She is a big draw as well," says Anders Justin.

Film education will be held on June 11-15 in the form of a camp week at Ålsta Folkhögskola.

Film camp is meant solely for girls and is supported by 100,000 SEK from the Swedish Film Institute, SFI, as part of the effort to empower women in the film industry.

Some examples of what will be taught include producing, directing, cinematography, editing and more.

Besides Alexandra Dahlström there will also be Bonnie Skoog Feeney, film producer, Lance Iga Mikkler, cinematographer and Lotta Grahn, project manager at Naïve.

"Sewing together a good mix of young female professionals in the film industry has been our ambition. It is to highlight the possibilities for women to actually succeed in the film business and provide good role models," says Anders Justin.
